## South Africa Demurrage and Detention Terms - April 2025

### Demurrage Definition

This fee is applicable when the customer holds carrier equipment in the terminal / overstay facility for longer than the agreed amount of free time. It can be incurred for both exports (early drop-off) and imports (late pick-up).

Export Demurrage days are counted from gate-in (full) to container loading date minus the free days.

Import Demurrage days are counted from container discharge to gate-out delivery (full) minus the free days.

Demurrage is applicable to all containers that remain at a terminal or overstay depot location longer than the agreed free time.

### Detention Definition

Detention charges occur when the consignee holds onto the carrier's container beyond the detention free time that is allotted as prescribed by the line.

Export Detention days are counted from pick-up empty to gate-in full minus the free days.

Import Detention days are counted from discharge full (*discharge full "next day" for Durban Pier 1 and Pier 2 only*) to gate-in empty minus the free days.

Detention fees are applicable to all containers that remain in the customer's possession longer than the agreed free time as prescribed below by the shipping line.

### Import Demurrage

**Standard demurrage** free-time is 3 calendar days from discharge next day for all container types.

**Reefer Peak:** During Peak Reefer Season demurrage free days will be reduced down to 2 free days (applicable to reefer shipments only). For Port Elizabeth and Durban the season will commence on 1 May and end on 31 October. For Cape Town the reefer season will commence on 15 November and end 31 March.

**Demurrage Freetime Extensions:** Any extensions to Terminal freetime that is published by TPT will be captured on a container level for terminals DCT, Pier 1 and CTCT and are applicable to containers dwelling inside the terminal only. For NCT and PECT the last free date will be set and extended on a vessel level.

**Special** refers to BBK / OOG equipment.

For Pier 1 if Block Release and DET Start Trigger is different then block release will be used as start trigger for DET calculation. For all other terminals in South Africa detention start trigger is discharge same day. IMO Class 9 will follow DRY deterntion terms (both days and rates)

### Overstay

**Overstay Definition:** When uncleared / cleared containers are moved by the line from the terminal to a depot facility that is treated as an extended port facility. Removing boxes from the terminal within the demurrage free time is a terminal requirement that if not executed can result in vessel operations being negatively impacted and lead to terminal congestion.

**Overstay Depot Rates** - These will follow the first rate slab for the terminal where the container has been discharged. The rate will be a flat rate, per day multiplied by the the amount of days that container has dwelled in the the Overstay Facility.
