SUMMARY

ADDITION TO IMDG CIRCULAR NO 2 AMENDED ON 29/08/2014

1. BACKGROUND

In addition to the IMDG circular no. 2 amended on 29/08/2014. According to the Port Rules for the commercial ports of South Africa and TNPA Standards and Procedures, adopted in terms of the National Port Act No. 12 of 2005 (“the Act) all IMDG handlers are hereby instructed to adhere to the following regarding IMDG handling in the Port of Durban

2. PROCEDURE

CARGOES THAT MUST EXIT THE TERMINAL WITHOUT DELAY (DIRECT DELIVERY)		
a.	Class 1	Explosives: Allowed at pier1&2 only UN.0012/0044 CLASS1.4 ROAD HAULING (TFR EMBARGO) All class 1 cargoes Explosives Ammonium Nitrate must be treated as explosives. All explosives must have SAPS permit
b.	Class 2.1	Flammable Gases
c.	Class 2.3	Toxic Gases
d.	Class 4.1	Flammable Solids: UN 1944 Safety Matches
e.	Class 4.2	Substance liable to spontaneous combustion.
f.	Class 5.1	Oxidizing Agents: UN 1748 Calcium hypochlorite no police permit UN1448 Barium permanganate UN1485 Potassium chlorate no police permit UN1495 Sodium chlorate UN1513 Zinc chlorate UN1942 Ammonium nitrate UN2067 Ammonium nitrate fertilizers UN 2880 Calcium hypochlorite No police permit
g.	Class 5.2	Organic Peroxides
h.	Class 6.2	Infectious substances: Generally not allowed, special permission must be obtained from the Harbour Master and Department of Health
i.	Class 7	Radioactive Material: Only allowed at terminals licenced by the National Nuclear Regulator (NNR)



NB:

- **Class 1 UN 0012 class 1.4 road hauling**
- **The ship will not be berthed if the required no. of trucks is not available. The truck registration number must be given to TPT and TNPA before the ship arrives. The trucks must complement the number of containers to be collected.**
- **Class 9 - UN 2212 and 2590 requires registration forms from the department of environmental affairs. To be transported by road to and from the terminal. Can be stacked at the terminal.**
- **Documents must be submitted through IPMS**
- **At the port of Durban movement of explosive must be by rail only**
