Emissions Surcharge (EMS/ESS) for LCL shipments

Dear Customer,

Maersk has reviewed the Emissions surcharge (EMS/ESS) for Q2 2024 and the tariff will be effective 01 April 2024.

Emissions surcharge will be applied to all bookings with Load port and/or Discharge port country part of EU/EEA.

It is collectively decided that an additional **USD 2 W/m** will be charged towards Emission surcharge Q2 2024 and will be applicable from 1st Apr 2024 onwards for all LCL shipments subject to quarterly review.

The surcharge will be payable by the payer of Ocean Freight and will follow the Ocean Freight currency.

This is a mandatory surcharge to all spot and contract shipments with only exception being ECO delivery shipments as advised below.

*For all bookings from China (Hongkong/Taiwan not included), we will add the emissions surcharge to the base freight rate for regulatory reasons. Base freight rate will be adjusted quarterly (increase/decrease) to reflect quarterly updated Emissions surcharge.

*ECO Delivery Bookings will not be charged with emissions surcharge. Choosing ECO Delivery means we replace fossil fuels with green fuels. This investment reduces green-house-gas emissions of your bookings and decarbonizes your supply chain. [Learn more about ECO Delivery.](#)
